### Volume 4 “CHILDOODS AT THE CORE OF RESEARCH”

Deadline for papers submission: February 15, 2020

Publication date: July 2020

*New Childhood Studies* are conceived as an interdisciplinary forum dedicated to critical analysis as well as to research and debate on the lives of children and adolescent that inhabit our world. Within this overall framework, the fourth volume of the Journal SOCIEDAD E INFANCIAS aims to focus on research as a way to approach the reality in which childhood and adolescence is lived nowadays. Among the disciplines that are included within the framework of childhood studies, it is argued that when studying the social behavior of children it is appropriate to use research methods that are common in the social sciences. But, at the same time, the need of acknowledging children as actors is emphasized. In doing so, children relationships and cultures must be studied in their own right, and a knowledge based on their experience has to be pursued, giving voice to children and encouraging their participation during the research. However, it cannot be ignored that, in fact, much of what is known about children comes from other sources, such as the statistics ones. The most important thing is that the object of interest, that is, childhood and adolescence as social categories, can be observed from as many angles as possible.

Based on these ideas, SOCIEDAD E INFANCIAS calls on researchers to send their contributions so that the new volume offers a wide range of research experiences on, for and with children.

#### Types of works accepted:

- Papers for the monographic section: Original theoretical or empirical works on any topic related with the subject of “CHILDOODS AT THE CORE OF RESEARCH”.
- Papers for the miscellany section: Original theoretical or empirical works on any topic related with childhood and adolescence, and/or with the study of children and adolescent lives.
- Book reviews: Evaluations and critical analysis of published works on any of the topics of interest to the review.
- Other contributions: This open section will include different contributions on the developments of the fields of applied research, social intervention, children’s rights defence or project evaluation, mainly of those in which children and adolescents have been actively involved.

All submitted papers must be written in **Spanish** or **Portuguese**.
